The Arab American National Museum has an ongoing program called SURA Arts Academy (Sura is Arabic for photo).

It's a digital photography instruction program, with a diversity theme, that is catered to 6th - 8th grade students from Southwest Detroit. ♦ For the current semester, students meet every Tuesday after school from 3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m. at Munger Elementary School, located at 5525 Martin Street in Detroit. ♦ The entire program is free!

- Professional photographers from the College of Creative Studies (CCS) will teach students how to take quality photos.
- Digital cameras will be provided to students to use for their take-home assignments during the program.



- Some of the topics to be covered include citizenship, democracy, civic participation, appreciation of diversity, identity, culture, traditions, religion, travel, sports, dance, music and food. ♦ Wow!
