## Arts Workshops Take Center Stage

Music Hall Centre is excited to offer a weekend of classes taught by the stars.

This Saturday and Sunday, April 21-22, the Master Workshop series will be in session. ♦ The workshops are offered to youth of all ages, and they are jammed packed with tons of fun. ♦ Here's a sampling of what's in store:

Saturday, April 21:

- **Fosse Workshop** (11 a.m.-12:45 p.m.): Scott Jovovich, original Broadway "Fosse" cast member, teaches all the authentic moves and movement unique to Fosse's choreography.
- **Twyla Tharp Workshop** (1 p.m.-2:45 p.m.): Whitney Simler, star of the "Movin' Out" national tour and a Twyla Tharp dancer, introduces the secrets of the Twyla Tharp technique.
- **Tap Workshop** (Time TBD): "Bring in 'Da Noise, Bring in 'Da Funk" tap master, Marshall Davis Jr., leads this energetic and exhilarating class.



Sunday, April 22:

- **Ballet Technique Workshop** (12 p.m.-2 p.m.): Former Joffrey Ballet principal dancer and Music Hall's Director of Dance, Meg Paul, teaches this elegant and enriching class that helps dancers polish and refine their ballet technique.
- **"How to Audition" Workshop** (2 p.m.-3 p.m.): Learn the tricks of the trade from Meg Paul, also the Dance Captain of Broadway's Tony Award-winning musical, "Movin' Out."
- **Choreography Workshop** (3 p.m.-5 p.m.): Meg Paul continues with audition process by teaching and coaching dancers through choreography.
