Programs Designed with Parents in Mind Day Care and Tutoring Offered

The Family Life Center, a program of Northeast Guidance Center, is a safety net for children and families.

The program provides free drop-in day care at the Children's Corner for parents who are conducting job searches at the One Stop Career Center or attending appointments at the Samaritan Center. ♦ While the children are enjoying their time



there, Little Tikes IBM computers are available for use with preschool software, including Bailey's book house, Millie's math house and Sammy's science house. ♦ The preschoolers are able to improve cognitive thinking, learn numbers, letters and how to tell time.

The Center is open for business Monday through Thursday, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., and parents are allowed to leave their children there for up to three hours per week. ♦ In addition, families are encouraged to

participate in the Tuesday Creative Fun Days, which include storytelling, arts & crafts and sing-alongs.

The Center also conducts Tuesday evening tutoring clinics from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. for adults and children.

You'll be able to:

- Learn valuable techniques to increase your reading skills;
- Spend two hours a week with a tutor assigned to you;
- Use Little Tykes Young Explorer IBM computers.
